VIDYA DAKSHNA 2025-26 PROJECT BEGUN ON A HIGH NOTE

VIDYA DAKSHNA is the flagship program to support Education. The program aims to extend financial support to students hailing from underprivileged backgrounds to help them pursue their education. These initiatives encompass a wide spectrum of educational levels, ranging from primary and secondary schooling to higher education, including graduation, post-graduation, and vocational courses.

VIDYA DAKSHNA - 2025-26 was launched on 1 June 2025. We are overwhelmed by the enormous rush of students with receipt of over 1,000 applications.

Till June 30, we supported 365 students including 207 school students, 140 college students and 18 students pursuing higher studies. The project is running in full swing as we plan to help many more students under the project over the next three months.

AROGYAM

AROGYAM initiative is aimed at providing MEDICAL support. Through the AROGYAM project, we extend assistance to economically disadvantaged members of society requiring medical care. This assistance takes various forms, including direct support and referrals to hospitals or medical centres offering treatment and medications at subsidized rates.

During April-June 2025, MEET helped 72 patients by providing financial support for medical treatment aid 85 patients by providing medicines.

15 patients were supported for their cancer treatment. There was one case where a toddler suffering from bone-marrow decease survived with the timely treatment.

MEET INDIA FOUNDATION, AIDS COMBAT INTERNATIONAL, PATH DARSHAK CHARITABLE TRUST and KANDIVALI EDUCATION SOCIETY collaborated to host a seminar “HOW TO TAKE CARE OF YOUR HEART” on 27 April 2025 at Pancholia Hall, Kandivali.

Eminent panel Doctor Minal Sheth Radiologist and Doctor Sushant Yadav, Thunga Hospital shared important insights about healthy living, identifying signs of a heart problem, Do’s and Don’ts in case of Heart Stroke and treatment for cardiac disease.

Dr Minal Sheth explained how CRCA, a walk in screening test can help in early diagnosis of heart decease. Dr Yadav explained unhealthy diet, sedentary lifestyle are the key factors causing heart decease as also highlighted risks emanating from Diabetes and High Blood Pressure. The doctors also answered questions from the audience.

Dr Girish Trivedi, Founder of AIDS COMBAT International and MEET member co-ordinated the seminar and presented the vote of thanks. The program was well attended by people coming from all suburbs.

MEET, AIDS COMBAT INTERNATIONAL, PATH DARSHAK Medical PRAGATI MITRA MANDAL and KANDIVALI EDUCATION SOCIETY collaborated to host a seminar “AWARENESS ABOUT ORGAN DONATION” on 28 June 2025 at Pancholia Hall, Kandivali.

Shri Nilesh Mandlewala has dedicated his life to a noble cause. Hailing from Surat Shri Mandlewala runs **Donate Life** (<https://www.donatelife.org.in>), an NGO for over 20 Years with an unwavering commitment to Organ Donation. Through relentless awareness efforts and life-saving transplant facilitation Shri Mandlewala is Transforming Lives.

Through his heartfelt speech, he explained how a brain-dead person’s seven organs such as Heart, Liver, Small Intestine, Pancreas, Kidney, Lungs, Hands can help people suffering from organ failure such that they live a normal life. He also explained post death the Eyes, Bones, Heart Valve and Skin can be donated for transplant.

As of Today, Donate Life has procured a total of 1330 Organs and Tissue donations which gave new lease of life and vision to 1226 organ failure patients in our country and globe.

He enumerated numerous live cases of Heart transplant, Hands Transplant, Liver and Kidney transplant etc. where the patients survived and lives a healthy life, many years after the transplant. Being first of such awareness drive in Mumbai, the seminar got overwhelming response, and the auditorium was pack to capacity.

Shri Purushottam Pawar is Founder of The Federation of Organ & Body Donation” and member of “v4organs Foundation” (<https://v4organs.org>). Through his captivating speech Shri Pawar emphasised the need for donation of vital organs which otherwise reduced to ashes after death.
