In 2025, MEET India Foundation completed 15 years of humanitarian service. Over the years, MEET expanded its spectrum of activities to reach out to more people in need of support.

As we grow bigger, we endeavor to be more transparent, responsive and accountable to our stakeholders. We are pleased to present the fourth edition of LAKSHYA, a Quarterly Briefing that encapsulates key activities, events and accomplishments at MEET during the period. Oct-Dec 2025, the quarter gone by, was quite eventful. Key highlights of major events and activities:

- **Under ‘VIDYA-DAKSHNA-2025-26’, our flagship initiative to support needy students, we focused on college and post graduate students. Total 957 students got financial support under this project during the current year.**
- **Under “AROGYAM” initiative 412 needy patients were supported.**
- **Our CSR drive, aiming at collaborating with Corporates, continued to expand. During Oct-Dec 2025, 20 cases were adopted under CSR drive taking the total CSR cases for the year to 350 plus.**

OUR MISSION

VIDYA DAKSHNA 2025-26 PROJECT PROGRESSED WELL WITH ALL-TIME HIGH DISBURSEMENT

VIDYA DAKSHNA is the flagship program to support Education. The program aims to extend financial support to students hailing from underprivileged backgrounds to help them pursue their education. These initiatives encompass a wide spectrum of educational levels, ranging from primary and secondary schooling to higher education, including graduation, post-graduation, and vocational courses.

In the last leg of 'VIDYA-DAKSHNA-2025-26', we focused on college and post graduate students. Total **957** students got the financial support under this project during the current year including 627 school students, 312 college students and 18 students pursuing higher studies. The geographic reach expanded significantly with students from across Western and Central Suburbs of Mumbai and a few students from other states like Gujarat, Punjab, Kerala reached out to us for help.

AROGYAM

AROGYAM initiative is aimed at providing HEALTHCARE support. Through the AROGYAM project, we extend assistance to economically deprived members of society requiring medical care. This assistance takes various forms, including direct support, referrals to hospitals or medical centers offering treatment and medications at subsidized rates.

During Oct-Dec 2025, MEET helped 34 patients by providing financial support for medical treatment, 83 patients by providing medicines. Some infants going through bone marrow issue were supported for their treatment. There was one case where the patient suffered severe injury on his brain due to an accident. We helped them to our utmost capacity and also referred to other NGOs for help. Under the guidance and Mentorship of Dr. Girish Trivedi, we could reach out to needy patients at KHM and Shatabdi Hospital.
