In 2025, MEET India Foundation completed 15 years of humanitarian service. Over the years, MEET expanded its spectrum of activities to reach out to more people in need of support.

July-Sep 2025, the quarter gone by, was quite eventful. Key highlights of major events and activities:

- **In the last leg of ‘VIDYA-DAKSHNA-2025-26’ project, our flagship initiative to support needy students, we focused on college and post graduate students. Total 934 students got the financial support under this project during the current year.**
- **Under “AROGYAM” initiative 48 needy patients were supported during the quarter.**
- **A HUMIDIFIER machine for care of premature babies was donated to Shatabdi hospital, Kandivali West, Mumbai.**

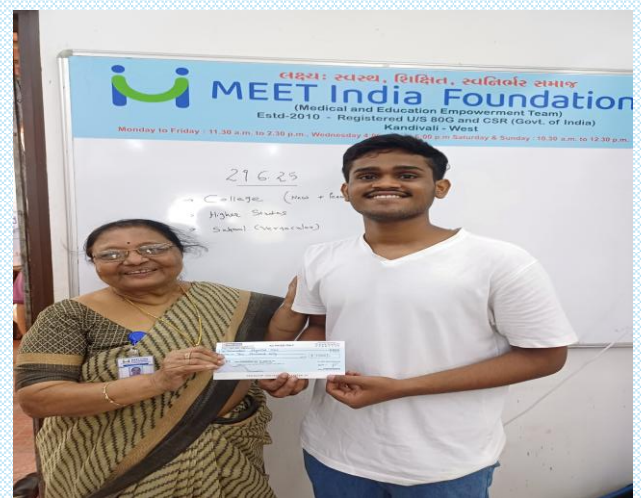
VIDYA DAKSHNA 2025-26 PROJECT PROGRESSED WELL WITH ALL-TIME HIGH DISBURSEMENT

VIDYA DAKSHNA is the flagship program to support Education. The program aims to extend financial support to students hailing from underprivileged backgrounds to help them pursue their education. These initiatives encompass a wide spectrum of educational levels, ranging from primary and secondary schooling to higher education, including graduation, post-graduation, and vocational courses.

In the last leg of 'VIDYA-DAKSHNA-2025-26', we focused on college and post graduate students.

Total 934 students got the financial support under this project during the current year including 616 school students, 300 college students and 18 students pursuing higher studies. The geographic reach expanded significantly with students from across Western and Central Suburbs of Mumbai and from other states like Gujarat, Punjab, Kerala reached out to us for help.

AROGYAM

AROGYAM initiative is aimed at providing MEDICAL support. Through the AROGYAM project, we extend assistance to economically disadvantaged members of society requiring medical care. This assistance takes various forms, including direct support and referrals to hospitals or medical centres offering treatment and medications at subsidized rates.

During July-Sep 2025, MEET helped 48 patients by providing financial support for medical treatment and 99 patients by providing medicines. Many cancer patients were supported for their treatment. There was one case where a young boy was brutally burnt by tar coal. We extended all round help for his treatment as also supported his family during these turbulent times. The boys is fully recovered and taken up a job.

*Under the guidance and Mentorship of **Dr. Girish Trivedi**, we could help many patients directly as also reach out to needy patients at KHM and Shatabdi Hospital.*

AROGYAM Highlights:

The patient has survived a dreadful accident but injured his right side of the head brutally which has impacted his functioning of brain severely. He is under treatment with MEET support and recovering
