### VIDYA DAKSHNA (Education support)

VIDYA DAKSHNA is the flagship program to support Education. The program aims to extend financial support to students hailing from underprivileged backgrounds to help them pursue their education. These initiatives encompasses a wide spectrum of educational levels, ranging from primary and secondary schooling to higher education, including graduation and post-graduation courses.

### AROGYAM (Healthcare support)

AROGYAM initiative is aimed at providing Healthcare and Medical support. Through the AROGYAM project, we extend assistance to economically deprived members of society requiring healthcare. This assistance takes various forms, including direct support and referrals to hospitals or medical centres offering treatment and medication at subsidized rates.

Over the years, MEET supported over Three thousand patients helping them recover and live a normal life.

### SWANIRBHAR (Social support)

SWANIRBHAR is a unique initiative to help people become self-reliant and earn a livelihood for their family. We strive for the empowerment of individuals to embark on the journey of entrepreneurship. There have been fulfilling success stories where, with our small financial help, differently-able people, widow have become self-sufficient and earning livelihood for their families by setting up vegetable / fruit / food / cutlery vending stalls, pursue vocations such as tailoring, beautician services.

### KAUSHALAM (Skill Development)

KAUSHALAM is our unique initiative launched in collaboration with specialized institutions to fulfil increasing need to support young people in acquiring Job-Oriented skills. Curated short-term courses are designed and offered to provide skill training, making the participants employable and assisting them in finding entry level jobs.

### ANNAPURNA (Social support)

Amidst the unparalleled challenges posed by the COVID-19 pandemic, MEET INDIA FOUNDATION stepped in to assist struggling families, distributing free food-grain kits to over 1,000 households grappling with severe financial distress. Our ongoing ANNAPURNA initiative continues to provide essential grocery to numerous impoverished families and senior citizens having no support.

### PARIVARTAN PUSTAKALAYA (Library)

MEET INDIA FOUNDATION runs a public library in kandivali Mumbai in the name of "Parivartan Pustakalaya," in association with Gujarati Bhasha Bhavan of Kandivali Education Society (KES).

Housing an extensive collection of over 7,000 books spanning diverse genres such as literature, biography, spirituality, and health in Gujarati, Hindi and English language. Serving the community for over three decades, the library attracts readers of all age groups: Children to Youngsters and Senior citizens, seeking to immerse themselves in the world of literature.
