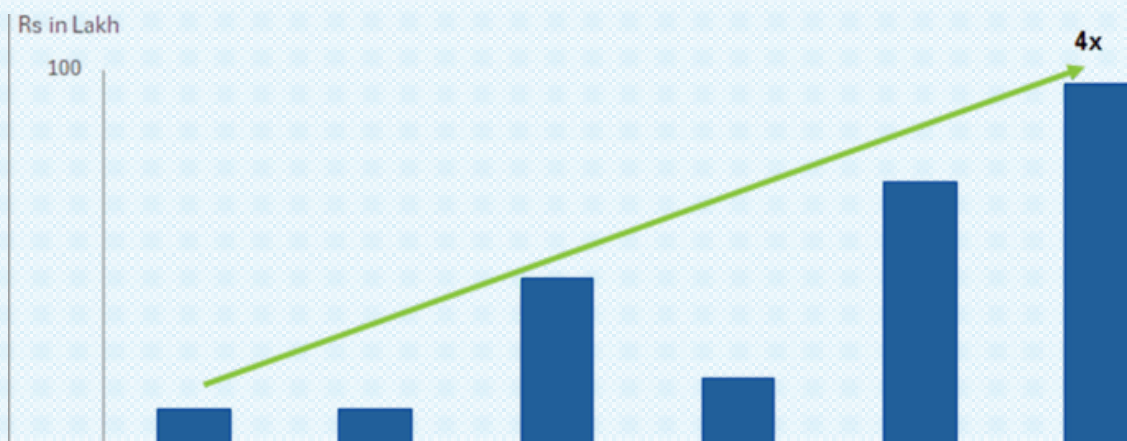

FY 2025–26 marked exemplary performance across all fronts.

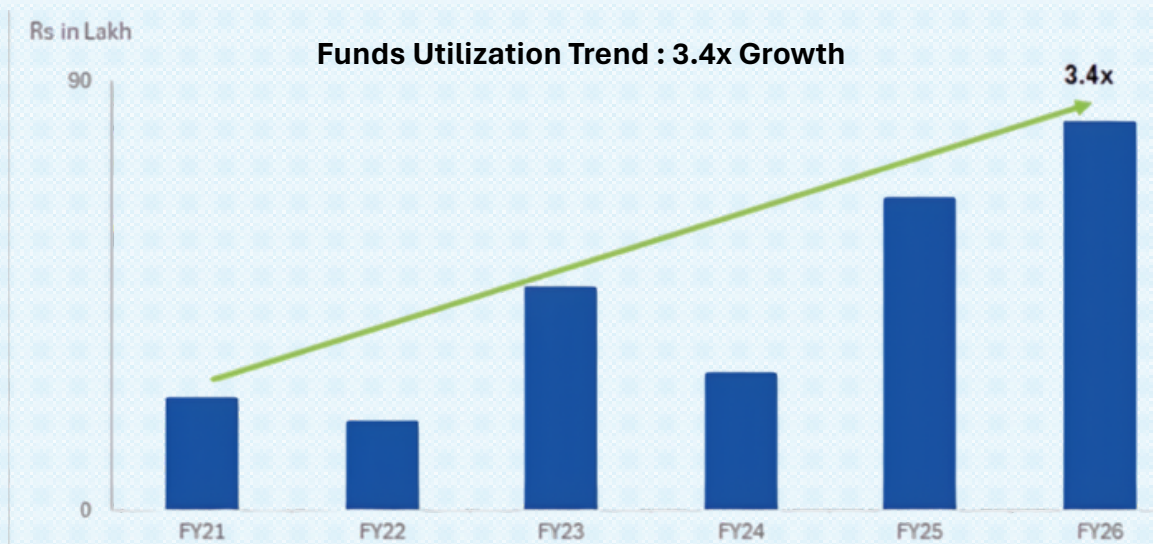

Donation Receipts Trend : Fourfold Growth



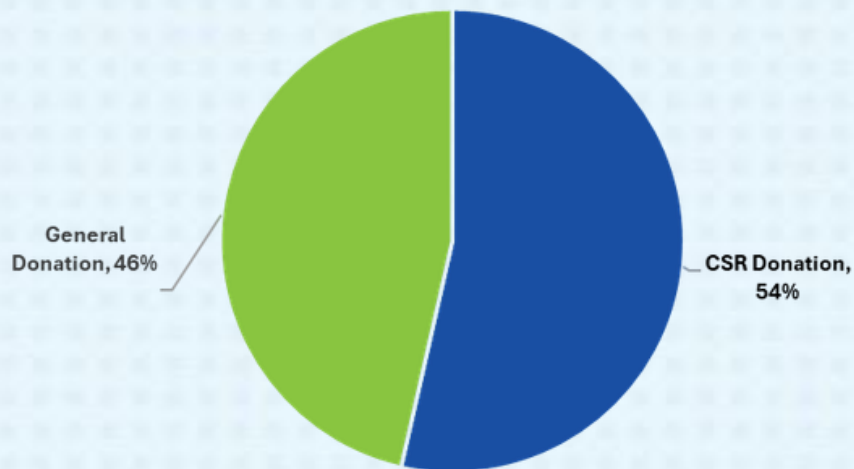
Funds Utilization Trend : 3.4x Growth



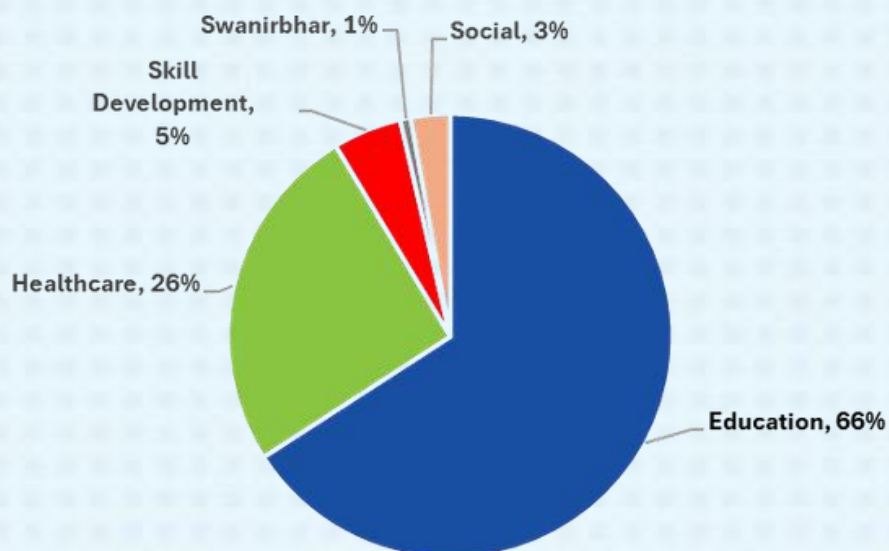

VIDYA DAKSHNA 2025-26 PROJECT PROGRESSED WELL WITH ALL-TIME HIGH DISBURSEMENT

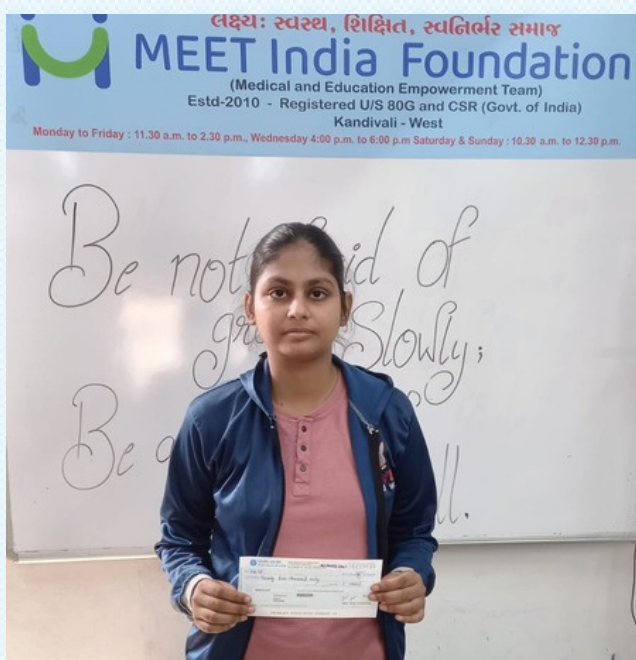
VIDYA DAKSHNA is the flagship program dedicated to supporting education. The program aims to extend financial assistance to students from underprivileged backgrounds, enabling them to pursue their academic aspirations. These initiatives cover a wide spectrum of educational levels, ranging from primary and secondary schooling to higher education, including undergraduate, postgraduate, and vocational courses.

During the year FY25-26, MEET supported 992 students, including 11 Divyang Children and 124 children from single-parent families.

AROGYAM

Through AROGYAM, MEET provides:

- Financial assistance for critical treatments
- Access to subsidized healthcare
- Medical Equipment support to Hospitals

During FY25-26, MEET extended support to over 500 patients suffering from critical diseases by providing medicines and financial assistance.

KAUSHALAM

KAUSHALAM (Skill Development) is our new initiative, aimed at enhancing employability among youth. Wide spectrum of curated courses such as Accounting, Banking and Finance, Logistics & Ware Housing, Retail Sales, Digital Literacy, Beauty & Hair Specialist, Technician etc. are designed and offered in collaboration with specialized institutions. We also assist them in finding entry-level job opportunities.

During the year FY25-26, MEET conducted skill development courses in collaboration with two institutes RAJ Foundation and ABHILASHA Foundation. Total 42 students were imparted career-oriented skills such as Accounting and Finance, Beauty Therapist, Computer literacy etc.

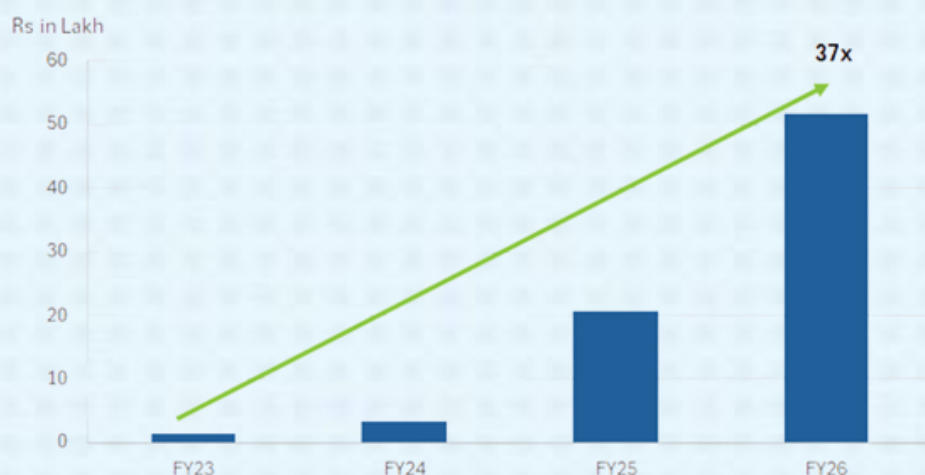

Strong Momentum in CSR Initiative

Since obtaining CSR-1 registration the Ministry of Corporate Affairs in 2023, MEET has witnessed exponential growth in corporate participation, with CSR contributions increasing 37x over four years constituting 54% of the total donations in FY25-26.

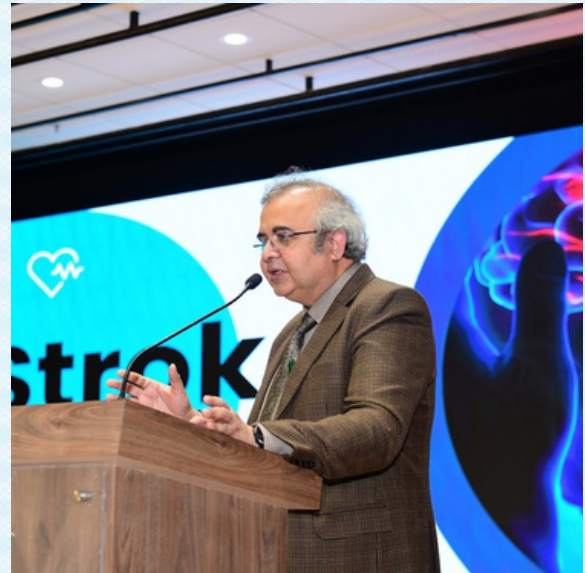
