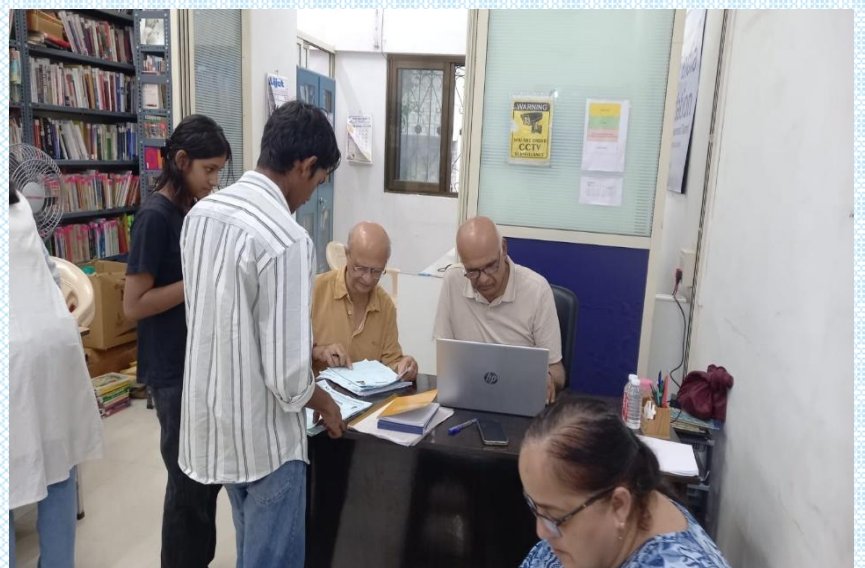

The program spans the entire educational journey, supporting students from primary and secondary school through undergraduate, postgraduate, and vocational education, enabling them to build brighter futures through learning.

Key Highlights In the first month of the VIDYA DAKSHNA 2026-27 :

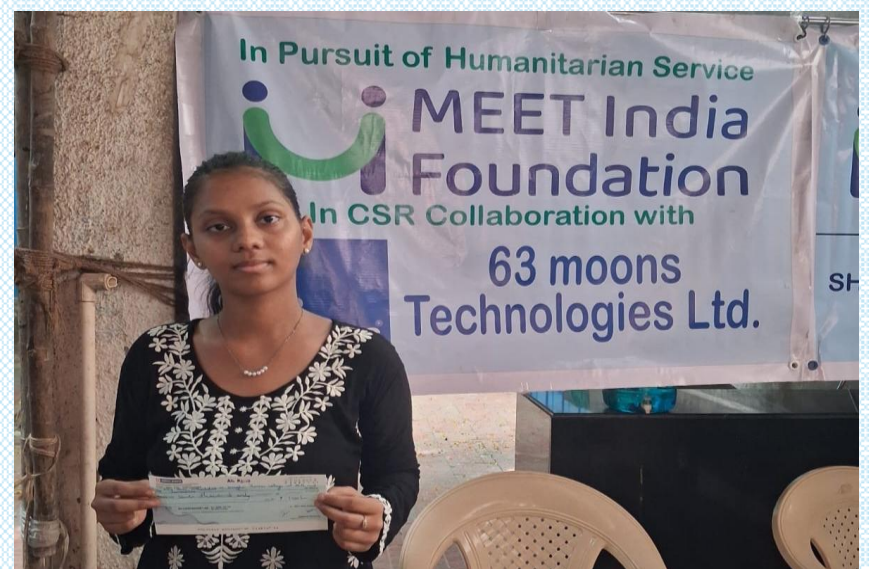
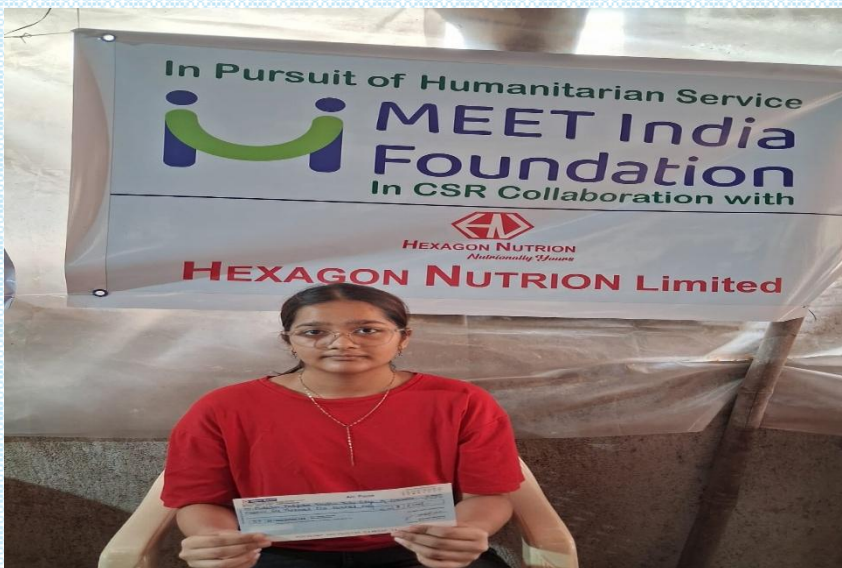
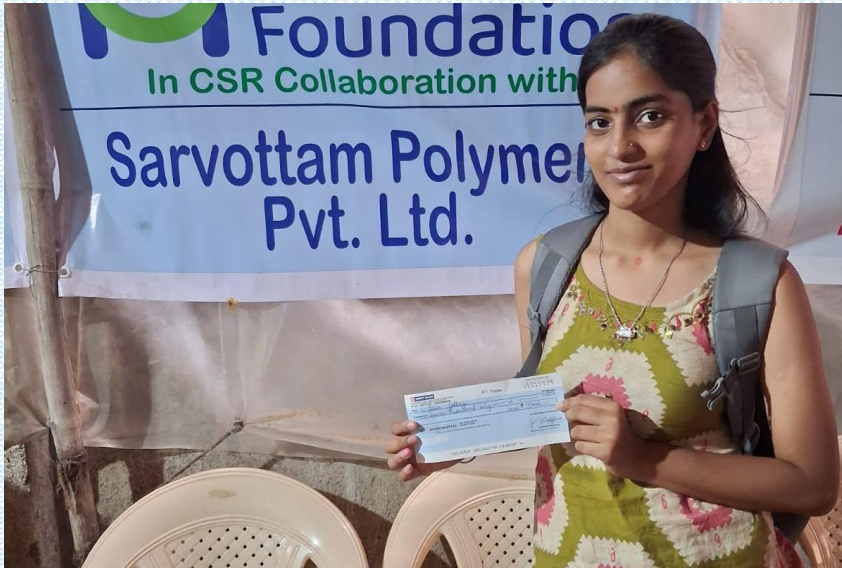
- **502 students supported : 263 Male, 239 Female students**

AROGYAM

AROGYAM initiative is aimed at providing MEDICAL support. Through the AROGYAM project, we extend assistance to economically disadvantaged members of society requiring medical care. This assistance takes various forms, including direct support for medicines, referrals to hospitals or medical centers offering treatment and medications at subsidized rates.

- Donated PEDIATRIC VENTILATOR, a critical equipment for infant children's ward at Shatabdi Hospital, Kandivali West
- Donated Ten Cradles for Infant Ward at Shatabdi Hospital, Kandivali West



SWANIRBHAR

Swanirbhar is a transformative initiative designed to empower individuals to become self-reliant by creating sustainable livelihood opportunities, enabling them to achieve financial independence and provide for their families.

MEET collaborated with **Sneh Jyot Trust** – An NGO working for supporting Physically challenged or Differently abled people.

In April 2026, the second vocational course “**Beauty Therapist Training Program**” was successfully completed in collaboration with the Abhilasha Foundation, empowering 20 women with vocational skills.



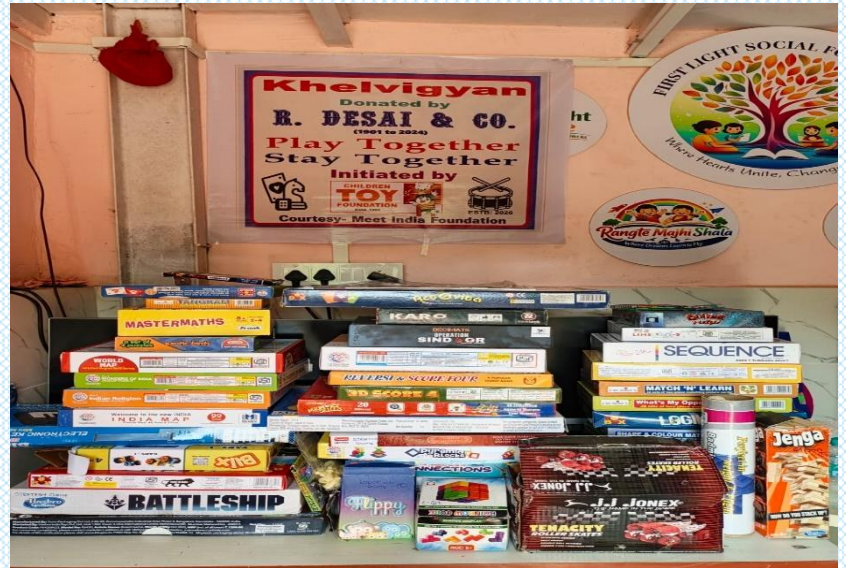
SUPPORTING NGO WORKING FOR TRIBAL CHILDREN AT AAREY, MUMBAI

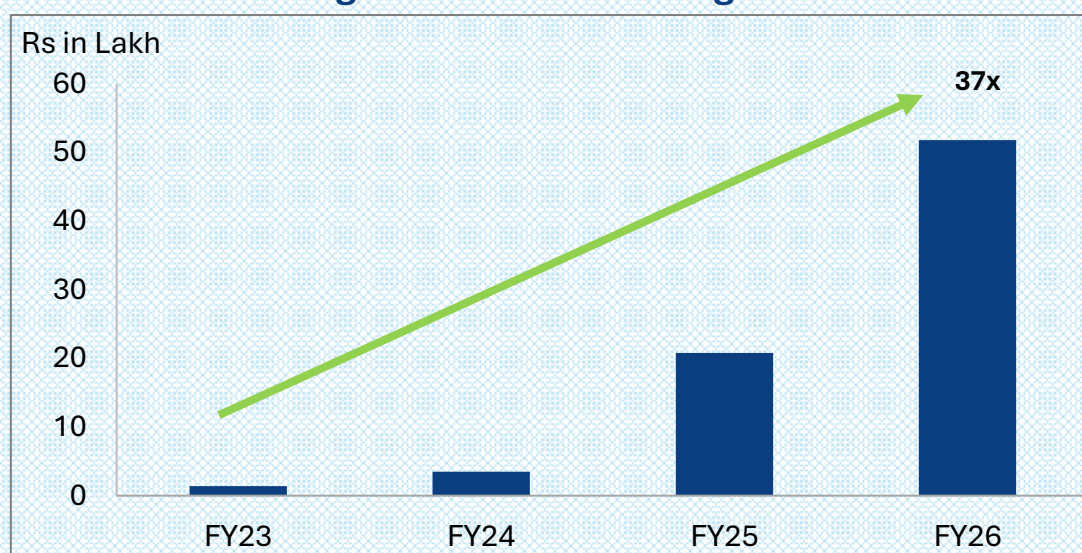


CSR INITIATIVE ON AN OVERDRIVE
